A resolution authorizing the submission of a grant application to the National Association of Conservation Districts, for a Urban and Community Conservation Grant in the amount of \$30,000, and authorizing the execution of documents relative to the submission and later acceptance of such grant.

WHEREAS, the National Association of Conservation Districts (NACD) is accepting applications for the Urban and Community Conservation Grant to address issues of conservation technical assistance related to conservation in urban, community, and small-scale agricultural production.

WHEREAS, the Mission Resource Conservation District (MRCD) finds it in the best interest of the citizens within its jurisdiction including Bonsall, De Luz, Fallbrook, Oceanside, Rainbow, and Valley Center to apply for funding on a cost-share basis; and

WHEREAS, upon MRCD receiving award of the grant, MRCD intends to allocate funds necessary to meet any, and all funding requirements for grant; and

WHEREAS, MRCD designates the Board President as the grantee's authorized official;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MISSION RESOURCE COSERVATION DISTRICT FINDS:

That the Board President or his designee is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the NACD, for funding assistance in the amount of \$30,000 for the Urban and Community Conservation Grant. The Urban and Community Conservation Grant funding opportunity requires a 25% match.
